

# Executive Order -- National Defense Resources Preparedness

The authority of the President ... to require acceptance ... to allocate materials, services, and facilities .

- (1) .... food ... livestock ... domestic distribution of farm equipment and commercial fertilizer;
- (2) .... all forms of energy;
- (3) ... health resources;
- (4) ... civil transportation;
- (5) ... water resources; and
- (6) ... all other materials, services, and facilities, including construction materials.

provide for the modification or expansion of privately owned facilities

The head of each agency engaged in procurement for the national defense is delegated the authority of the President

persons of recognized expertise from various segments of the private sector

to employ persons of outstanding experience and ability without compensation and to employ experts, consultants, or organizations.

all modes of transportation

all forms of energy

all commodities and products

all usable water, from all sources
